As you live out the Christian life, what does 'hearing with faith' look like?

Should they be any different? Same?

Day Five

Read Psalm 1:1-3

Apply this to your life. Write out what this looks like moment-by-moment:

Is your delight in the law of the Lord? Why or Why not?

What are some of the solutions presented by the Psalmist?

Day Six

Read Jer 17:5-13

What does it mean to trust in man, make flesh his strength?

What does it look like to be a shrub in the desert?

What does it look like to bear fruit?
